BE A PILOT FOR A DAY

Saturday, June 16, 2018

In case of inclement weather, event will be held on Sunday, June 17, 2018.

- ✈ Where: Fort St. John Airport CYXJ
- ✈ When: June 16, starting at 8:00 AM. Flights will be staggered throughout the day.
 - Weather permitting. In case of poor conditions, the event will be moved to the following day, Sunday, June 17.
- ✈ Who: Any interested kids or youths between the ages of 8-17.
- ✈ Cost: Free of Charge!
 - Limited to 120 Junior Aviators.
- ✈ How: Pre-Register by emailing copa4kids@hotmail.com.
 - Pre-Registered Junior Aviators will have priority.
- ✈ Junior Aviators will experience:
 - A chance to examine a working aircraft, close-up!
 - A 20 minute ground school, conducted by a pilot, explain various parts of an aircraft. Questions are welcome!
 - A walk around inspection. See how pilots prepare for flight!
 - A flight in the front seat (if possible) of an aircraft. Junior Aviators will observe all of the facets of flight: start-up, take-off, landing, and shut-down. Flights run between 15 and 45 minutes, depending on weather and number of participants.
 - Total experience is 1½ to 2½ hours.
