### Old Business:

### New Business:

6. We will offer the BCCPAC conference attendance to the treasurer, as an incentive to volunteer for the position. We will discuss this in September.
7. Discussion about the Meet and Greet and how to get families out. Maybe have a gym night, some food. Linda made a motion to plan the event as if it was going to happen, then if job action gets in the way, we can cancel it. Andrea seconds the motion. Passed.

In the beginning of September, an impromptu meeting will be called to arrange the details.
