Dear Families,

We wanted families to know we have been missing you this week, the school is a strange place without students and families. This past week was a planning week for teachers. Teachers have been in contact with families via email. We are so thankful for the work our staff has done this week, to prepare for a new way of learning. With a new way of learning, comes many different guidelines and expectations.

Connecting with students and families next week, will be the top priority for teachers. With guidance from Ministry of Education documents, the Continuity of Learning Plan will focus on the key areas of Literacy and Numeracy. The learning plans will continue to be a work in progress and we appreciate your patience.

We recognize the importance of keeping at-home learning manageable for families. As we embark on this new way of learning together, there are a few key things to keep in mind. For one, we are not in any way expecting you to fill your child's day with simulated "school" at home. Even though we have full trust in your abilities, we recognize that the classroom can't be replicated at home. In this time of worries and stresses, the last thing we all need to do to each other is add more anxiety, especially to our children. For this reason, we are really wanting to emphasize that any work we offer is just that; an offer of support that you may or may not choose to use as it is presented. Secondly, we recognize that there are many factors that will determine how you are working with your children at home. Whether it's work, access to wifi or technology, etc., how you decide to structure your learning time at home will be dependent upon your individual family situation. You will set a routine that works for you and your family. As the learning plans are shared, teachers will be incorporating your feedback. Teachers will be available throughout the school day to help their students. The format of communication and online platforms will vary by classroom, grade, and teacher.

The administration team will continue to send a weekly letter to families with the Laker News. Please read the Laker News for more specific information about student supply pick-up, which will take place the week of April 14-18. Most importantly be safe, stay healthy, and stay tuned for Monday Morning and Spirit Day video messages from Mrs. Maxfield and Mr. Clements.
