

Reading Incentive Program

This year we will be continuing our Reading Incentive Program. As before, students will fill out the Reading Incentive forms for themselves to help in reaching their reading goals. Students wishing to participate can pick up a green sheet located outside the office, and return their completed form, to the office, by the end of the first week of the following month.

In class reading is a part of the school curriculum and will not be eligible for the Reading Incentive Program

This is a volunteer program for students. They need to know that this is for fun, and NOT homework.

K-grade 2 students will receive a free book, regardless of the amount of minutes read, just for participating.

Normal minimum reading requirements for students per month is:

200 minutes----- 1st free book and 1st draw ticket

500 minutes or over----- 2nd free book and 2nd draw ticket

Students can pick out their own books from a variety that are offered each month. This program runs from October to April. Each month there will be a draw for three \$10 gift certificates to Cole's book store, as well as other incentive prizes soon to be announced.

Last year we had a draw for a Tablet at the end of the year, which was successful at increasing student participation. I'm excited to announce that this year we will be doing a draw at the end of the year for TWO Tablets!
